The little Garter

4 balls of Kinna. Cheval Blanc

Needle size US 8

2 large buttons

Sweater made in size 4/5 years

All in Garter Stitch

I decided to write down and publish this pattern since many people had favoured this project in Ravelry... My English is a little poor, so excuse me and tell me if there are any mistakes...

le p'tit lexique/ **Chart Key**

tric. : tricoter / **Knit**

m. : maille / **Stitch**

aug. : augmentation. Tricoter 2 fois la maille suivante : on tricote dans le brin de devant puis dans le brin de derrière avant de faire tomber la maille

KFB : Knit in front and back loops

dim. : diminution. Tricoter 2 mailles ensemble

K2tog : Knit 2 stitches together

a.m. : anneau marqueur

pm : place marker / sm : slide marker

rab. : rabattre / **Bind off**

la p'tite astuce/**the little trick**

Je place toujours, pour du point mousse, une épingle à nourrice sur le devant de l'ouvrage (rangs impairs) afin de bien le repérer, ce qui aide pour compter ses rangs et pour placer sur l'envers les fils créés lors des changements de pelotes.

I always place for the garter, a safety pin on the front of the work (odd rows) to better locate, which helps to count its ranks and to move towards the thread created when changes of balls.

les p'tites expli. / **Instructions**

Cast on 55 stitches

Knit in Garter stitches 48 rows

Row 49 : increase 10 stitches and knit the 55 stitches on the needle

Row 50 : increase 10 stitches and knit the 65 stitches on the needle. (there are 75 Stitches)

Row 51 to 56 : Knit

Row 57 : Knit 1, KFB., pm., Knit 71 stitches, pm, KFB., Knit 1. (there are 3 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 58 to 60: Knit

Row 61 : Knit 2, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 2. (there are 4 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 62 to 64 : Knit



Row 65 : Knit 3, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 3. (there are 5 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 66 to 68 : Knit

Row 69 : Knit 4, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 4. (there are 6 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 70 to 72 : Knit

Row 73 : Knit 5, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 5. (there are 7 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 74 to 76 : Knit

Row 77 : Knit 6, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 6. (there are 8 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 78 to 80 : Knit

Row 81 : Knit 7, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 7. (there are 9 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 82 to 84 : Knit

Row 85 : Knit 8, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 8. (there are 10 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 86 to 88 : Knit

Row 89 : Knit 9, KFB., sm., Knit 71 stitches, sm, KFB., Knit 9. (there are 11 sts each side of marker rings)

Rows 90 to 92 : Knit

Row 93: Knit 11, sm., Knit 23 stitches, cast on 25 stitches, Knit 23 stitches, sm,, Knit 11. (there are 5 sts each side of marker rings) (that is to say, that are bind off the 25 sts in the center and that they stop increases at the edges)

Continue on one side.

Rows 94 to 98 : Knit the 34 stitches (sm of course) and leave these stitches

Knit the other side

Rows 94 to 99 : Knit the 34 other stitches

Row 100 : Knit 34 stitches, cast on the 25 stitches, and knit 34 stitches (sm of course)

To the end of the 100 row, the neck is make and all the stitches are on the same needle.

Row 101 and 102 : Knit

Row 103 : Knit 9 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 9

Row 104 to 106 : Knit

Row 107 : Knit 8 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 9

Row 108 to 110 : Knit

Row 111 : Knit 7 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 7

Row 112 to 114 : Knit

Row 115 : Knit 6 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 6

Row 116 to 118 : Knit

Row 119 : Knit 5 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit

Row 120 to 122 : Knit

Row 123 : Knit 4 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 4

Row 124 to 126 : Knit

Row 127 : Knit 3 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 3

Row 128 to 130 : Knit

Row 131 : Knit 2 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 2

Row 132 to 134 : Knit

Row 135 : Knit 1 , K2tog, sm., Knit 71, sm., K2tog, knit 1

Row 136 to 140 : Knit

Row 141 : Bind off the first 10 stitches

Row 142 : Bind off the first 10 stitches

(20 stitches total are folded down and sleeves are formed. It is 55 sts on needle.)

Row 143 to 190 : Knit (=47 rows)

Row 191 : bind off 20 (there are 35 stitches on the needle)

Knit 30 Rows and bind off all the stitches, the pocket is make.

Fold and secure the pocket. Sew side and back (and fixed by an invisible point) armholes. Sew on buttons.

It is possible to make crochet borders to better finish the sweater.
