Beanie ()ne

This hat has the advantage of being unisex, with sizes very easily adaptable to the owner, and be made in an extremely soft and high quality thread. The finishes can be various: with or without pompom, possibly an acorn, or any other creation that will make a unique beanie.

<u>sizes</u>: adult medium (57/58cm of hat size), <u>child 6/8</u> <u>years old</u>.

Materiel:

2 balls of Munki, Anny Blatt. Knittng kit available there.

Circular needles 5.5mm with a cable of minimum 60cm. Cable needle, one stitch marker.

Points and abbreviations.

st: maille

k: maille endroit

p: maille envers

P2tog : Purl 2 stitches together.

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together.

mlk: make an increase an knit it.

mlp: make an increase and pur lit.

... knit the motive between * and * as many times as necessary to finish the round.

R: round.

<u>Cable 1</u>: over 8 st, put 4 stitches on the cable needle in front of the work, k4, take back the stitches of the cable needle and knit them.

<u>Cable 2</u>: over 7 st: put 3 stitches on the cable needle in front of the work, knit 2 stitches together, and then knit 2, take back the 3 stitches of the cable needle and knit them. Note: at the end of this cable, you have 6 remaining stitches.

<u>Ribs 1/1</u> with circular needles, always knit this round: *kl, pl*.

<u>Gauge</u>, stockinnette 10cm/10cm needles 5.5mm : 15st, 20 rounds.

Model Camille Delahaie, Les aiguilles de Camille.com. Private use only.

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Work:

Cast on $\frac{70}{10}$, 80 st in long cast tail or very flexibly, form the circle, put the stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the round, and knit 10 rounds in ribs $\frac{1}{10}$.

Then for the child size, make this increase round: *k2, mlk, k2, mlk, k2, pl, mlp*. At the end of the round you'll have 100st.

For the adult size, knit this increase round: *k4, mlk, k3, pl, mlp*. At the end of the round you will have 100 st.

Keep on knitting the 8 following rounds: 3 times for the child size, 4 times for the adult size:

R 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 and 8: *k8, p2*

R 5 : *Cable 1, p2*

Start to decrease, it's the same for both sizes:

R1: *k8, P2tog*

R 2: *k8, pl*

R 3: *k3, K2tog, k3, p1*

R 4: *k7, pl*

R 5 : *Cable 2, pl*

R 6: *k6, pl*

R 7: *k4, K2tog, p1*

R 8: *k5, pl*

R 9: *k3, K2tog, p1*

R 10 : *k4 p1*

R 11: *k2, K2tog, p1*

R 12 : *k3, p1*

R 13: *k1, K2tog, p1*

R 14 : *k2, p1*

R 15 : *K2tog, p1*

Cut the thread to 30 cm long, pass the thread in all the stitches and secure the top of the cap. Tuck in all the threads and cut them flush. Make a pompom or a tassel if necessary and fix it at the top of the beanie.
