

Capelet 4 saisons

2 sizes : **Medium** and Large

Materiel :

1 ball of Latino Plassard

Circular needles 4,5mm

1 stitch marker of 1 color.

21 to 23 stitch markers (contrasting color compared to the single marker)

Yarn or tapasstry needle, scissors, blocking material (optional).

Points and abbreviations :

R : round

st : stitch

p : purl

k : knit

SKP : Slip, knit, pass over

K2tog : knit 2 stitches together

Yo : Yarn Over

* ... *: work the indications between * and * as many times as necessary to reach the end of the round.

Seed stitch with circular needles :alternate these 2 rounds as much as indicated:

R 1 : *k1, p1*.

R 2 : *p1, k1*

Lace stitch :

Round 1 :* SKP, Yo, k1, Yo, k4, K2tog*.

Rounds 2, 4, 6 , 8 and 10 :* k* .

R3 : *SKP, k1, Yo, k1, Yo, k3, K2tog*

R5 : *SKP, k2, Yo, k1, Yo, k2, K2tog*

R7 :*SKP, k3, Yo, k1, Yo, k1, K2tog*

R9 :*SKP, k4, Yo, k1, Yo, K2tog*.

Gauge : seed stitch 10cm/10cm : 26 stitches/32 rows.

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Work :

Cast on 198 or 216 stitches depending on the size chosen. Form the circle, put the marker in single color and start making 10 turns in the seed stitch.

During your last round of seed stitch, place stitch markers every 9 stitches to define each lace motif.

Make the lace pattern 5 times (or knit with the diagram below):

The white boxes are knit stitches.

When the lace patterns are done, remove the markers that were used for the lace and keep the one that marks the start of the round. Knit 10 turns of seed stitch, in the last round of seed stitch, put a marker every 18 stitches.

Start to decrease: **Medium Size**

R1 : *k16, SKP*. (187st)

R2 : *k*

R3 : *k15, SKP * (176st)

R4 : *k*

R5 : *k14, SKP * (165st)

R6 : *k*

R7 : *k13, SKP * (154st)

R8 : *k*

R9 : *k12, SKP * (143st)

R10 : *k*

R11 : *k11, SKP * (132st)

R12 : *k*

R13 : *k10, SKP * (121st)

R14 : *k*

R15 : *k9, SKP* (110st)

R16 : *k*

R17 : *k8, SKP * (99st)

R18 : *k*

R19 : *k7, SKP * (88st)

R20 and 21 : *k*.

Rounds 22, 24, 16 and 28 : *k1, p1*

Rounds 23, 25, 27, and 29 : *p1, k1 *.

Round 30 : bind off flexibly.

Bring in the threads, cut them short and block if necessary.

Decreases : **size Large**

R1 : *k16, SKP * (204st)

R2 : *k*.

R3 : *k15, SKP* (192st)

R4 : *k*.

R5 : *k14, SKP* (180st)

R6 : *k*.

R7 : *k13 SKP * (168st)

R8 : *k*.

R9 : *k12, SKP * (156st)

R10 : *k*.

R11 : *k11, SKP* (144st)

R12 : *k*.

R13 : *k10, SKP * (132st)

R14 : *k*.

R15 : *k9, SKP* (120st)

R16 : *k*.

R17 : *k8, SKP * (108st)

R18 : *k*.

R19 : *k7, SKP * (96st)

R20 and 21 : *k*.

Rounds 22, 24, 16 and 28 : *k1, p1*

Rounds 23, 25, 27, and 29 : *p1, k1 *.

Round 30 : bind off flexibly.

Bring in the threads, cut them short and block if necessary.
