

Risoux

Bonnet for Adult (head size: 57 to 60 cm)

Material:

2 balls of [Country Tweed Cheval Blanc](#) (50g/100m.),

Needles 5mm, a sewing needle.

Points:

Seed stitch:

Row 1: *knit 1, purl 1*, repeat from *to* and finish with knit 1.

Always repeat this row; all the stitches are so opposed

Seed Ribs:

Row 1 (on the wrong side): 1 selvedge stitch, *knit 3, purl 1, knit 1*, repeat from *to* and finish with knit 2 and 1 selvedge stitch.

Row 2 (on the right side): 1 selvedge stitch, purl 2, *knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2*, repeat from *to* and finish with 1 selvedge stitch.

Always repeat these 2 rows.

Decrease: knit 3 together.

Work:

Cast on 79 stitches, do the first row (on the right side): knit all

On the wrong side of the work, begin to knit with the seed ribs up to 10 cms in height.

Then, **on the right side of the work**, knit with the seed stitch up to 25 cms in height.

Start decreasing, still using the seed stitch, on the right side of the work:

Decreasing 1 (right side): knit 2 stitches, then: (K3tog, knit 7 stitches) 8 times, finish with knitting 4 stitches.

Decreasing 2 (right side): knit 2 stitches, then: (K3tog, knit 5 stitches) 8 times, finish with knitting 2 stitches.

Decreasing 3 (right side): knit 2 stitches, then: (K3tog, knit 3 stitches) 7 times, finish with knitting 6 stitches.

Decreasing 4 (right side): knit 2 stitches, then: (K3tog, knit 1 stitches) 7 times, finish with knitting 4 stitches.

Make the wrong side row to with 19 remaining stitches; get away the thread from 50 cms in height.

Make the sewing by taking care of inverting when by arriving at ribs so that points do not see.
