



Vintage Pattern Reprint USA c. 2005 PatternBee

TO MAKE BABY SHOES:

A strip of felt; light blue, pink or white (even light tints of yellow and green are suitable) cut 6 x 14-inches will make one pair.

Cut 2 of each piece, reversing B and C for opposite shoe.

Face C across top and down front with felt or satin to line.

Punch small holes as indicated and use a buttonhole stitch with matching floss to finish them.

Embroider French knot motif on B pieces in pink with green lazy daisy leaves, or other desired colors.

A half circle of felt may be used to reinforce heels if desired.

Using four strands of matching embroidery floss, stitch the pieces together with small, even, straight stitches. Match notches—a to a and b to b.

Then sew A to B (step 1), B to C (step 2), D to BC (step 3); lace shoes with baby ribbon. Trim off notches.

Pattern may be reduced or enlarged to make doll shoes or shoes for a larger baby.
